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Meeting called by: ASC Board of Directors & Coaches      Type of meeting: Parent/Skater Information Meeting

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1. Expectations of Skaters at practice sessions:

- Skaters are to arrive at the arena with enough time to prepare for their on-ice session and enter the ice at the designated start time.
- Skaters must ask permission to leave the ice during their practice times. If their primary coach is not present they need to ask one of the other coaches.
- Skaters are not permitted to leave the ice to speak with their parents or another visitor, sit in the stands, sit in the music room, lobby or club room.
- Cell phones are not permitted at ice level except for the purposes of video recording with your coaches permission.
- Skaters must use their training time to train. Standing and chatting is not productive and can be a safety hazard.
- If a skater needs to re-lace their skate/s they must get off the ice into one of the players benches to do so.
- If a skater falls down they should get up immediately and resume skating unless they have suffered an injury that prevents them from doing so.
- Skaters should, when time permits, do a pre-training warm-up and an after training cool down.

2. Expectations of Parents at practice sessions:

- Parents are asked to get their child to the arena with enough time to properly prepare for their session.
- Parents are not permitted at ice level and must refrain from 'coaching' their children before, during or after skating.
- Parents are asked to respect their coach's decisions and trust that they are being given the best information & coaching for their child. Please do not compare the information & coaching that your child is getting to that of another child. Many factors play a role in determining what is in the best interests of each skater and no two are the same. Concerns should be addressed to your coach, not in the lobby or stands.

3. Expectations of all members of the Abbotsford Skating Club:

- Show respect toward all members of the club, at all times, regardless of circumstance. Concerns should be brought to your coach or a board member in a private & respectful way.
- Competition & test applications are the responsibility of parent & skater. Every effort is made to ensure all members are aware of registration openings & deadlines.
